			It is hereby defined as any cause,
			which is beyond the control of the
			Supplier or the WBSFP&HDCL,
			which such party could not foresee
			or with a reasonable amount of
			diligence could not have foreseen
			and which substantially affects the
			performance of the contract, such
			as-
			i. War, Hostilities or warlike
			operations (whether a state of war
			be declared or not), invasion, act of
			foreign enemy and civil war.
			ii. Rebellion, revolution, insurrection,
			mutiny, usurpation of civil or
			military, government, conspiracy,
			riot, civil commotion and terrorist
			area.
			iii. Confiscation, nationalization,
			mobilization, commandeering or
			requisition by or under the order of
			any government or de facto
			authority or ruler, or any other act or
			failure to act of any local state or
			national government authority.
			iv. Strike, sabotage, lockout, embargo,

- shortage of power supply epidemics, quarantine and plague.
- v. Earthquake, landslide, volcanic activity, fire flood or inundation, tidal wave, typhoon or cyclone, hurricane, nuclear and pressure waves or other natural or physical disaster.
- If either party is prevented, hindered vi. or delayed from or in performing any of its obligations under the Contract by an event of Force Majeure, then it shall notify the other in writing of the occurrence of such event and the circumstances of the event of Force Majeure within fourteen days after the occurrence of such event. The party who has given such notice shall be excused from performance or punctual performance of its obligations under the Contract for so long as the relevant event of Force Majeure continues and to the extent that such party's performance is prevented, hindered or delayed.
- vii. The party or parties affected by the event of Force Majeure shall use reasonable efforts to mitigate the effect of the event of Force Majeure up to its or their performance of the Contract and to fulfil its or their obligation under the Contract but without prejudice to either party's right to terminate the Contract.
- viii. No delay or non-performance by either party to this Contract caused by the occurrence of any event of Force Majeure shall:

	Constitute a default or
	breach of the contract.
	Give rise to any claim for damages or additional cost or expense occurred by the delay or non-performance. If, and to the extent, that such delay or non-performance is caused by the occurrence of an event of Force Majeure.
7	The cost of sample of the Papaya seed (Red Lady variety) to be drawn by the State Seed Testing Officials will be borne by the Corporation. After collection of the seed sample, the packets will be sealed by the Corporation's official since receiving of the germination report from the State Seed Testing Laboratory.
8	The selected Bidder will be issued a letter of intent and he shall have to submit the letter of acceptance and to execute warranty within three calendar days from the date of receipt of the letter of intent.

Other stipulations will remain unchanged.
