No. 792/FPI & H/2E(H)-23/2010 dt. 03.06.2015 — In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased hereby to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the posts of (i) Assistant Horticulture Extension Officer and (ii) Udyan Palan Projukti Sahayak in the Directorate of Horticulture under the Government of West Bengal in the Department of Food Processing Industries & Horticulture:-

RULES

The method of, and qualifications required for, recruitment to the posts of (i) Assistant Horticulture Extension Officer and (ii) Udyan Palan Projukti Sahayak in the Directorate of Horticulture under the Government of West Bengal in the Department of Food Processing Industries & Horticulture, shall be as detailed below:—

Name of the Post (1.) (i)

Assistant Horticulture Extension Officer;

Appointing Authority

Director of Horticulture, Government of West Bengal;

(iii) Method of Recruitment

By promotion in consultation with the Staff Selection Commission, West Bengal, from amongst confirmed Udyan Palan Projukti Sahayaks having at least 10 (ten) years' continuous and satisfactory service in the regional

and field offices under the Directorate of Horticulture:

Name of the Post (2.) (i)

Udyan Palan Projukti Sahayak;

(ii) Appointing Authority

Director of Horticulture, Government of West Bengal;

(iii) Method of Recruitment

By Selection (Direct Recruitment) through the Staff Selection Commission,

West Bengal;

- (iv) Qualifications
- : (a) Passed Higher Secondary or Equivalent examination with Science Subjects / Vocational (Agriculture) of a recognised Council or Board; and
 - (b) Knowledge of Bengali / Nepali (for hill areas of Darjeeling district),Spoken and Written;

(v) Age

Not less than 18 (eighteen) years and not more than 40 (forty) years on the 1st January of the year of advertisement; relaxation shall be allowed in case of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Physically Handicapped and Ex-Serviceman as per Government rules and orders for the time being in force.
